

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual World's Steepest Hillclimb Proves Nasty

Idaho's other hillclimb, the World's Steepest, fired up for the second time on Saturday, May 21, 2011. Over the last few years, the only motorcycle hillclimb in Idaho, the annual Big Nasty, has created a pool of hundreds of new hillclimbers in the Northwest. So it only makes sense to the Big Nasty guys to continue to run a much smaller, "pre-Nasty, to keep the new climbers going strong and encourage more new climbers to get on board. The World's Steepest, together with the Big Nasty, and April's Northwest Nationals in Yakima, Washington comprise the new 2011 Northwest Hillclimb Series.

Like last year, there were few spectators. In an effort not to devalue the Big Nasty brand or confuse anyone, absolutely zero advertising was done for this event, other than an e-mail to riders. Posters weren't even hung up, making this a kind of "underground, word-of-mouth" event. But a number of new riders showed up anyway, with a total of 153 entries coming from as far away as San Francisco.

The World's Steepest is run on its own completely separate set of hills, about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile past the Big Nasty. This event offered two, completely separate hills; each one was about 500 feet, and each one offered its own share of challenges. All of the stock bikes ran on last year's hill, which was fairly healed from last year, and all of the modified bikes ran on a brand-new hill with no tracks on it, about 200 feet to the left. Nothing is ever easy in Big Nasty Land, and only five riders managed to make it over the trophy hill, led by Austin Kouba, who was the only 250 to scale the hill, which like its name suggests, is really, really steep near the top.

After a quick intermission, the trophy altered, semi-pro, and 450 pro classes fired up on the brand-new hill to the left. As most of the riders had predicted, the new altered hill was harder than the trophy hill, and making it over the top was very difficult. Meridian's Chase Seal pounded his modified CR85 Honda up to 409 feet to win the mini semi-pro class, and a number of talented, "young" riders performed extremely well. But the day featured a string of great rides from the "older" guys that had to be seen to be believed. At 65, Nampa's Jerry Williams has had some serious health problems, but he looked like a 20-year old as he clawed over the hill in 19.6 seconds to win the vintage altered class, beating a bevy of far younger riders. Like last year, Lodi, California's Lefty Frueh had an awesome weekend, setting the fast time on the trophy hill, winning several classes and showing no signs of slowing down at age 69. Lefty was the only rider who topped both the stock and the altered hills. Nampa, Idaho's Dennis Harmon also blew over the hill to win the senior semi-pro class. Finally the 450 pros lined up and Snohomish, Washington's Gerrett Hopkins flew his Honda over the top, setting the fastest time of the day on the altered hill at 15.830 seconds.

The “biggie” event, of course, and the third and final round of the Northwest Hillclimb Series, and the final round of the 2011 NAHA (North American Hillclimbers Association) Series, is Idaho’s largest motorcycle event, the Big Nasty Hillclimb, which will be held on September 16-18, 2011.
