

2011 Northwest Hillclimb Series



Maybe you've joined 12,000 other people at Idaho's largest motorcycle event, the Big Nasty, every September. Maybe you've even ridden in it, (or wanted to). Here's your chance to ride two more, way-cool hillclimbs, as you prepare for the return of the Big Nasty this fall.....



Round 1: Fri, April 29, "The NW Nitro National" Yakima, WA

This really cool, 700-foot hill hasn't been used since 1999. Trophy and semi-pro classes run Friday, pros run Saturday and Sunday.



Round 2: Sat, May 21, "The World's Steepest" New Plymouth, ID

Not the tallest, not the longest, just a really fun, 450-foot hill that gets steeper and steeper, the higher you go, and is located 1 mile past the Big Nasty hill.



Round 3: Fri/Sat, September 16-17 "The Big Nasty" New Plymouth, ID

Join over 12,000 people, and ride at night under the lights, as part of Idaho's biggest and wildest motorcycle event, and find out for yourself why Big Nasty Land is known as *the place where NASCAR meets Burning Man*.

Please visit our website to get entry forms and additional information. No memberships of any kind are needed. You CAN register on-site (it costs more to do it that way instead of pre-registering). Rounds 1 and 2 are designed more for amateur, "trophy" riders and are all about having affordable fun, (round 3 is the standard Big Nasty with 2 ½ days of everything, from top pros to mini bikes. At rounds 1 and 2, we are also giving riders, longer than normal runs at the bottom, to get you higher up, or over the top, of the hills. Minis and some other classes will ride, shorter, easier routes.

Rounds 1 and 2 will feature all regular trophy classes, from minis to 450's and extended classes, plus all of the regular semi-pro classes from 90X, up to 60-up pro, (semi-pro classes compete for a purses based on 70 percent payback). The only regular pro class will be the 450 pro class that uses NAHA rules, and will compete for a 70 percent payback purse. Any current NAHA-licensed pro CANNOT enter any trophy classes, (EXCEPT the 3 altered classes) but CAN ride in the 450 pro, and the appropriate semi-pro classes. Minis compete for 50 percent trophies, all other trophy classes compete for 33 percent trophies.

Points will be kept for all trophy classes for all 3 of these events, and each trophy class winner will receive a special Idaho State Hillclimb Champion award at the end of the season.

Round 1 is located near Yakima, WA. Rounds 2 and 3 are located on the Pence Ranch, 4 ½ miles north of New Plymouth, Idaho. See website for map. All rounds start with small, trophy bikes.

Class Entry Fees:

Minis - \$15 pre-register, \$25 at event (50% trophies)

All other trophy classes - \$25 pre-register, \$35 at event (33% trophies)

Semi-Pro 90's (minis) - \$35 pre-register, \$50 at event (70% cash payback)

Remaining Semi-Pro & 450 pro classes - \$45 pre-register, \$70 at event (70% payback)
